Program Structure

Tony has created a highly adaptable structure for your organization as well. You could choose an orientation and eight subsequent group sessions that run about 69-90 minutes each; plus additional outside meetings for the peer partners. Or offer the material in a workshop format as full 8-hour training day. The session time frame of 60 -90 minutes adapts to the number of individuals you have in your course; the more participant usually means you will need more time for everyone to get a chance to participate. Usually 8-10 is a nice sized group.

You may easily apply and adapt this training format to:

- Missionary Teams
- Traditional churches of any size
- House Churches
- Small or large Ministry Teams
- Small or large Cell Groups
- Other non-profit ministries
- Retreats, conferences, family camp, workshops, Sunday School, mid-week classes and teleconferencing

Tony has ingeniously incorporated basic learning and teaching styles into this training. As a result, anyone can achieve measurable, positive outcomes on a personal, group or facilitator's level. There are many advantages to this program over others. Besides the points listed above, this format also:

- Adapts easily to differing cultures and ministries
- Adapts to small or large groups
- Provides concrete action steps for healthy accountability, walking in excellence and promoting spiritual, personal and professional growth
- Easily demonstrates how to build the power of community into our busy lives and ministries

And as a coach, I just have to say here, that the quality of the materials themselves is superior. When you are watching the DVDs, the audio and visual are crystal clear and adaptable for a large screen or small; and the printed materials are laid out in a very easy-to-grasp way and have that tailored, professional look.

Also, the materials are set up so that any lay person can easily grasp the facilitators role while at the same time the coachees' workbook helps them easily to accomplish all stated objectives. User Experience

Recently, I sat down to interview a few leaders in our Christian community who have used the Peer Coach Training Program and I want to relate to you here what they had to say.

My first interview was with Jerry Graham, Ph.D., D.Min. and Certified Leadership Coach and Coach Trainer and who has been professionally coaching for a number of years; and is one member of Coaching Pastors, a coaching ministry and web site dedicated to pastors, their ministries and their leadership. Tina is very impressed at how easily the Peer Coach Training Program adapts to different cultures.
